Dear Parents,

We learnt how to write small sentences in Marathi. We translated English sentences to make Marathi sentences.

We learnt the following rules used for translation –

1. The verb changes based on the gender.
2. The verb in a Marathi sentence usually comes at the end of the sentence.

Translate the following sentences and write them in the notebook. Underline the verb.

1<sup>st</sup> year students -

- 1) I read. – मी वाचते / वाचतो .
- 2) She writes. – ती लिहिते .
- 3) He runs. – तो पळतो.

2nd year students-

- 4) I read a book. – मी पुस्तक वाचते / वाचतो .
- 5) She writes a letter. – ती पत्र लिहिते .
- 6) I do my studies. – मी माझा अभ्यास करते / करतो.

All students -

- 7) I wear clothes. – मी कपडे घालते / घालतो.
- 8) I like red color. – मला लाल रंग आवडतो.
- 9) I have two hands. – मला दोन हात आहेत.
