

Marathi Intermediate Project: Due May 4, 2008

We will have a “Show and Tell” project for the Marathi Intermediate children. They will tell a short story about their vacation or any trip (examples: India trip, Europe trip, trip to Orlando or the beach, trip to a museum or zoo etc.). The location is not important.

The child should be able to tell the story in complete sentences in Marathi.

1<sup>st</sup> year students are expected to say at least 5 sentences. 2<sup>nd</sup> year students are expected to say at least 10 sentences.

They are welcome to bring photographs, or any drawings to help them tell the story and make it fun for them. It doesn't have to be a fancy presentation. This is meant for the children to construct and talk complete sentences.

For the 1<sup>st</sup> year students, sentence construction using proper rules will be important.

For 2<sup>nd</sup> year students, sentence cohesion and story formation ability will be important in addition to sentence construction (this is required for them to prepare for Marathi Advanced class).

As we will dedicate one entire session for the show and tell, we will have about 4 to 5 minutes per child for the story.
